Battisford Parish Council Emergency Response Plan

Introduction

The purpose of this document is to identify risks to the community within the village of Battisford that would likely require support from the Parish Council (BPC), either immediately or subsequently. It outlines the roles and responsibilities required to neutralise the incident to Support a return to normality.

Scope

This plan does not seek to encompass those activities and responsibilities undertaken by statutory agencies, such as Fire, Police, Medical Local Authorities etc. It does however indicate how the BPC can facilitate and assist such agencies with local support, premises and knowledge where required. The effectiveness of local liaison and assistance should not be underestimated.

BPC undertakes, within its powers, responsibilities and ability, to assist with the support of the vulnerable during a crisis scenario.

Review

This plan must be reviewed every 12 Months, however ongoing consideration and update should be undertaken to adjust to circumstances at each BPC Meeting.
